- -Need less props/drama better instruments
- -Put money back into kids
 - -Clinicians for every instrument once per week
- -Percussion clinician coming tomorrow
- -More budget to staffing (money was used for Flagstaff instead this year)

Get every child auditioning for all-state Mid-May music. Work on it in summer camp (put show on hold)

Get every child doing Solo and Ensemble

Reuse and re-outfit this year's props, hope to have less than 17% for props!!

Emphasis on a well-rounded musician and person, not winning, not marching
